Norton Lindsey Parish Council has no objections to the proposed building work / internal restructuring of Glebe House, Canada Lane, Norton Lindsey, but has some concerns regarding the vague comments made on both the planning application and the design statement regarding rendering of the brickwork which, if carried out, would make this dwelling a dominant feature due to its elevated position in the landscape. The changing of the windows to white plastic would alter the mellow tones of the property and together with the rendering would make it significantly different from the overwhelming number of brick faced houses in this part of the village.
